Subject : Adolescent Programme for the Girl students

All the District Programme Coordinators, RMSA are hereby instructed to hold the Adolescent Programme for the Girl students as approved by PAB - 2016-17 at school level as per guidelines mention below :-

- 1) Each district may select 10 Govt. Girls' Schools/Co-Ed Schools in 4(four) blocks each to implement the programme. Girl students will be made conscious about Life skills and Personal development, Child Rights, Health, Hygiene, Nutrients, Gender equality, parts of the Human Body, changes due to adolescent stage, Menstrual Hygiene, Reproductive process in Human, Awareness aids, Sexual abuse, Child trafficking and Social awareness through this programme.
- 2) 1(one) day awareness camp for the adolescent girls may be organized non-residentially in selected 10 (ten) Govt. girls' schools/Co-Ed schools of selected block as a part of the programme.
- 3) The programme will be conducted by trained Resource person/teachers. District authority may contact with District Health & Family Welfare/Health Education authority to provide preferably trained lady Resource person. The Resource person may be paid Rs. 1000/- as honorarium.
- 4) A biology teacher preferably lady teacher of the school may be engaged as Coordinator of the programme.
- 5) A fund of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) will be sanctioned to each selected school of the block (i.e. 10 schools x 10,000/- = 1 lac).
- 6) School wise performance report with good quality photographs alongwith Utilization Certificate (Hard & Soft copy) of the programme may be sent to RMSA State Office soon after the completion of the programme.

Fund is being allocated separately to each district in respect of the programme. The programme may be implemented within August, 2016.
