DATE OF INCIDENT: Incidents which have occurred between July 1, 2020 and September 30, 2021 will be considered for the 2021 awards. The Selection Committee, may at its discretion, relax the date by a maximum period of six months prior to July 1, 2020 if it so deems fit.
