NOTIFICATION

Subject:- Adoption of norms for provision of teachers and ministerial staff in Primary (JB), Upper Primary (SB), High and Higher Secondary Schools in the State of Tripura.

The existing norms for provision of teachers and ministerial staff in respect of Primary (JB), Upper Primary (SB), High and Higher Secondary Schools including those receiving grant-in-aid from the Government have been reviewed by the high power committee constituted by the Government for preparing approach paper and action plan for implementation of Rastriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhiyan.

In consideration of all aspects with particular reference to the minimum requirement of teachers and ministerial staff in the schools, a revised set of norms has been accepted by the committee concerned with an aim to improve quality of secondary and higher secondary education in a significant way.

It has, therefore, been decided that the norms as accepted by the committee shall stand adopted with immediate effect in supersession of all orders issued earlier in this regard.

The norms to be pursued are indicated at page-2.
