Subject :- Kishori Utkarsh Manch for the Secondary Girl Students.

All the District Programme Coordinators, RMSA are hereby instructed to hold the Kishori Utkarsh Manch for the Secondary Girl students as approved by PAB 2016-17 at District level. The objective of the programme is as follows:-

The girl students having extraordinary talent hardly get scope to share their success story with others. Kishori Utkarsh Manch is a District level platform where the girl students having extraordinary caliber can expose and showcase their talents which will ultimately help them to enhance their excellence. This Manch at the district level also recognize their talents by rewarding them and give an opportunity to share their success story with the girl students of secondary stage of different High & Higher Secondary schools to be invited as audience with a view to inspire them.

The PAB in 2016-17 has sanctioned Rs.32.00 lakh for implementing the project. So, the District Programme Coordinators (DEOs) of all Districts are instructed to organize the programme as per following guidelines:-

- 1. 2-Day residential programme at district level may be organized as Kishori Utkarsh Manch.
- 2. The girl students securing high marks in Annual Examination of Class-VIII and Class-IX now reading in Class-IX and X respectively, girl students securing high marks in Madhyamik Examination now reading in Class-XI (At least securing above 50% of marks) from each High & Higher Secondary School under each District may be invited to participate in the Manch.
- 3. The girl students achieved recognition at State level or above in the field of games and sports, cultural activities, social activities, best volunteer of NSS/NCC/Scout and Guides during 2015-16 may also be invited in the Manch.

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- 4. Extra ordinary performance in extra academic examinations (like Math Olympiad etc) may also be invited in the Manch.
- 5. The total participants from each school should be limited to 5 (five) only.
- 6. All the girl students participated in the Manch may be awarded with Mementoes and Certificates
- 7. Girl students of High & Higher Secondary Schools adjacent to the venue of the programme may be invited as audience.
- 8. A district level Committee may be constituted with Sabhadhipati of Zilla Parishad as Chairman, District Programme Coordinator as Vice Chairman and HM of any Girls Higher Secondary School as Convener along with PRI members, HMs of other schools, teachers and guardians as member. An indicative sample of the 2-Day programme is cited below for designing the programme:
 - i) Inaugural Session
 - ii) A speech of inspiration and motivation by noted & eminent ladies working in different field of the activities.
 - iii) Sharing of success stories by the girl student secured highest marks in Higher Secondary Examination of the concerned district/selected girl students of different categories i.e., academic/sports/cultural area (general/ST/SC/Minority)
 - iv) Showcasing of selected sports events by participating girl students.
 - v) Showcasing of selected cultural events by participating girl students.
 - vi) Round table discussion on contemporary educational/social issues. The participating girl students will participate in the discussion. HM of any H/S school will conduct the discussion.

9. BUDGET ALLOCATION :-

(A) A fund of Rs. 3.50 lakh may be allocated to each district for organizing the programme Kishori Utkarsh Manch at district level.

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(B) A 2-Day State Level Kishori Utkarsh Manch may be organized. A State Level Committee may be constituted with the State Mission Director as Chairman. The details of the programme may be formulated in the meeting of the State Level Committee. A fund of Rs. 4.00 lakh may be allocated for this purpose.

The District level programme is to be completed within 20th October, 2016 positively and District-wise performance report with good quality photographs, videos along with utilization certificate (Hard & Soft copy) of the programme may be sent to RMSA state office soon after the completion of the programme.

Fund is being allocated separately to each district in respect of the programme.
