MEMORANDUM

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 1.11.2018 in Conmt. Pet.(C) No.1706/2017 in SLP(C) Nos. 18993-19049/2014 in between Debashish Pal Chowdhury, Petitioner vrs Sanjeev Ranjan & Ors, Respondents (I.A. No.86004/2018-permission to file additional documents/facts) with M.A. No.1726/2018 in SLP(C) Nos. 18993-19049/2014 (XIV) (I.A. No.80881/2018-clarification/direction), has passed the following order:

"Having considered this matter, we are of the view that at this stage, we ought to permit the State of Tripura to continue to avail of the services of the terminated teachers until the end of the academic session 2020, meaning the academic session 2019-20. The above direction has been issued in the peculiar facts of the case and the circumstances which have confronted the State of Tripura and above all, the need to functioning of teaching activities in schools in the State of Tripura remains unaffected."

Pursuant to the above order, the services of terminated Graduate Teachers and Post Graduate Teachers appointed on ad-hoc basis vide this office Memo No.F.1(1-43)-SE/E(NG)/2017(Vol-II), dated 23.12.2017 and No.F.1(1-46)-SE/E(NG)/2017(Vol-II), dated 23.12.2017 respectively will continue till the academic session 2020 i.e. 2019-20 as per terms & conditions on their ad-hoc appointment.
