- The selected candidate would be appointed on purely contract basis for a term mentioned above and may be extended on performance and requirement.
- The selected candidate should come under an agreement as per the norms with the Directorate of Secondary Education (School Education Department), Govt. of Tripura.
- Candidates can apply for multiple positions, if he/she fulfills the criteria. For each position, application has to be submitted separately.

2. Eligibility Criteria, Job Responsibilities & Remuneration:

- Detail Term of References are given at Annexure-A.
- The last date of submitting application will be the cutoff date for calculating minimum length of relevant experience for respective positions.

3. Period of Contract:

- The consultant will be engaged on purely temporary and on contractual basis for a period of 12(twelve) months and may be extended on performance and requirement.
- All applicants must take this into consideration that the contract may be of shorter period. Those
 applying must agree to that condition.

4. <u>Remuneration of the consultant:</u>

- The monthly remuneration of the consultant will be Rs.1.00 lakh to Rs.3.50 lakh (negotiable). Negotiated remuneration to be fixed will remain unchanged during the term of contract.
- There will be no annual increment/percentage increase during the initial contract period of 12 (twelve) months.
- The income tax or any other tax liable to be deducted as per the prevailing rules will be deducted at source and for this, Department will issue TDS certificate.
- No DA (Dearness Allowance) shall be allowed during the period of contract.

5. Age Criteria:

 A candidate should be less than 65 years of age on the last day date of application (Candidate should be in good physical condition and willing to travel extensively in different parts of the State).

6. Leave Criteria:

- 01 day Casual Leave per month, 01 day Extra Ordinary leave per month and 10 days Medical Leave will be applicable in 12 months subject to prior sanction of leave by the Competent Authority.
- · Leave cannot be claimed as a matter of right.

1.Background: -

Tripura is a developing state in Northeastern region of India with fast paced economic growth combined with strategic efforts in enriching social and economic infrastructure. To cater to the development needs, every year several works under various Departments are taken up from different centrally or state Government sponsored schemes. School Education sector in the State has seen a rapid transformation in past 3 years with the position of the State in Performance Grading Index improving from Grade V in 2018 to Grade I in 2021.

With an enrollment of 99% in Primary level, School Education constitutes a very important stage in lives of all citizens as they get their first exposure to the world of learning. Unfortunately, this also happens to be the terminal stage of learning for many students who enter the workforce after completing this stage. The prime objective of school Education Department is to provide holistic, value based, 21st Century ready education with focus on skills and competencies among students so that they can face the emerging challenges and contribute to nation building in future. The Department of School Education has 4 implementing arms – Directorate of Elementary Education, Directorate of Secondary Education, SCERT and Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan Rajya Mission, Tripura. There are 2193 J.B, 1121 S.B, 606 High and 422 Higher Secondary Schools under state government in different parts of the state to ensure 100% accessibility for all students to gradual stages of school education.

Educational achievement/outcomes in Tripura remains influenced by the community and class of the Students, out of which the starkest difference is between that of Tribal and Non tribal students. Without upliftment of educational status of ST students, the overall education in the State cannot be improved.

Difference in 10th Std. Tripura Board of Secondary Education result between ST students & State average has been illustrated in the Table below:-

The Government is committed to raise the living standards of all its citizens and ensuring inclusive growth for all. The State Government launched Aspirational Block Development Programme with an aim to ensure comprehensive transformation in the socioeconomic status of the 12 most under developed block across the State. Most of the students in the Aspirational Block are from ST community. Major issues of these Aspirational Blocks are: -

- Higher dropout rates than State average in Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary & Senior Secondary levels.
- (ii) Wider gaps in learning outcomes.
- (iii) Inadequate infrastructure.
- (iv) Lack of access to 21st Century Skills.
- (v) Lack of vocational Education and Career guidance .
- (vi) Language barriers constraining foundational learning.

Aspirational block-wise different types of schools managed by School Education & Tripura Tribal Autonomous Area Development Council located therein are as under:

There are 108 High/Higher Secondary Schools in the Aspirational Blocks and 774 number of Junior Basic and Senior Basic schools. Funds from World Bank will be used to uplift the educational status of students in the Aspirational Block areas through provisioning of various educational services, creation of soft and hard infrastructure, continuous comprehensive teacher training and strengthening of educational governance of the schools involving all stakeholders. The project design employs the concept of School Complexes as enshrined in National Education Policy 2020 for achieving this end. 31 nos. Higher Secondary schools will be prioritized as they account for more than 25% of overall enrolment in these blocks and the major portion of fund allotted for infrastructure will be used in these schools and if any fund remain available for further investment will be used for the construction of few JB & SB Schools as model schools.

2. Objectives :

The primary aim of the project is to transform the schools to such institutions where no effort is spared to ensure the overall development of students with strong governance system based on common goals and sharing of resources.

The Key objectives of the project are as follows:

- Foundational Learning Enhancement
- · Capacity building of teachers at Elementary and Secondary level
- IT interventions in Schools
- · Vocational Education and hand holding for career enhancement
- Accessible education for Children with Special Needs and ensuring socioemotional wellbeing of all
- Provisioning of 21st Century skills
- · Strengthening of School autonomy and Governance

- Rational deployment of teaching/non-teaching resources
- Strengthening of school infrastructure to support the components of the scheme

3. Scope of Services :

The consultants will report to the School Education department/ PMU and work under the guidance, direction and control of PMU/ School Education Department. The Scope of services to be targeted under enriching Education in Aspirational Blocks of Tripura with the core focus areas such as developing schools into a participative learning organization to improve quality education for building a value based society. They will also assess in every Hub schools of Aspirational Blocks, the scope of comprehensive infrastructure development to support the interventions planned the most effective manner.

3.1. Engagement of individual consultants:

The consultant(s) will visit Hub schools as well as the feeder schools (Spoke schools) which will be connected with Hub schools and plan the gradual implementation of the project in the said school complex.

The consultant(s) will prepare all documents required for expansion of Physical infrastructure to support the new components, framework for ICT, Strategy for community engagement for school governance, guide lines for teacher training, foundational learning, vocational education and its rigorous implementation, monitoring etc.

The Consultants will prepare DPR incorporating all the components of the project. DPR should be in sync with the objectives of the project.

3.1.1. The Consultant will

- Provide technical assistance /advice/recommendations on standards, tools, guidelines, policies, procedures that can contribute to the strengthening of program operations like Foundational Learning Enhancement, Capacity building of teachers at Elementary and Secondary level, IT interventions in Schools, Vocational Education and hand holding for career enhancement.
- Visit field projects as per program requirements; coordinate for internal/ External technical assistance required by the project or as requested by field staff.

- Lead project design processes offering research, technical writing, partnership development, and technical expertise in all aspects of the process;
- Devise comprehensive implementation and monitoring and evaluation plans for new programs.
- Data analytics
- Build and maintain relationships with external and internal partners to enhance their understanding about program standards and strategies; may manage relationships with external resource partners and other stakeholders;
- Conduct long range strategic plans of all project components, plus operational aspects of application execution within infrastructure.
- Offer technical support to help to identify and resolve implementation problems and bottlenecks, advance progress of various activities and components, based on a thorough understanding of the development objectives and design of the project. Specific focus on monitoring of budgets and implementation progress of major activities and components.
- Create a motivating and comfortable atmosphere which will ensure Psychological well being and strengthen the students' desire to attend school every day and thus, complete their academic cycle better.
- Give suggestions and action to be undertaken on importance and incorporation technology like smart classrooms, IT infrastructure and other relevant technologies.
- Preparation of DPR and other reports as per need of the Department / PMU.
