**SUBJECT : - RESULT ANALYSIS IN GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS --
Inspection of evaluated answer scripts of Madhyamik Examination.**

The Madhyamik Board Exam is a crucial step in the academic life of students and thus, also, for their teachers and schools. For improvement in teaching pedagogies and strategy, as well as improving the academic performance of Government school students, it is necessary that there is an academic discussion and academic review in every staffroom in every Government school in the State.

Thus, it has been decided that HMs of each and every Govt. and Govt. aided High and Higher Secondary Schools along with 2(two) teachers preferably having Science/Math/English background will be allowed for inspecting/checking of 5 (five) nos. evaluated answer scripts per school randomly selected after publication of the result of Madhyamik Examination, 2019 onwards. The inspection/checking of evaluated answer scripts will be done at TBSE as per the scheduled given at Annexure-A.

The HMs/Teachers of respective schools shall inspect/check the randomly selected evaluated answer scripts (5 nos.) with sincerity and due attention so that they can go back to their respective schools and held an academic review meeting in which, subject wise the result of Madhyamik must be properly analysed and discussed subject wise and student wise. A comparison must be made with previous years also, at least of 2 previous years.

A presentation must be prepared by the teachers for discussion and minutes recorded in the Minutes Register in detail. Inspector of schools/District Education Officers must try to attend at least 8-10 such meetings in their jurisdiction.

Each DEO to submit a question wise analysis of each of the 6 subjects to Mrs. Ambalika Datta, Deputy Director, Science Promotion, SCERT, Agartala by 15th July, with academic recommendations regarding study materials, pedagogy strategy etc. General administrative recommendations like "We may adopt 10 children per teacher" are not welcome.

SCERT to organise a subject wise Expert Committee consisting from DIET faculties and subject teachers to go to TBSE office and examine at least 200 answer scripts randomly and then give a report on measures to improve performance of students in TBSE exam.

Secretary, Education (School) Department will review a presentation in this regard in 3rd week of July 2019.

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It is to be stated that Rs.250/- per answer scripts i.e. Rs.1250/- per school for 5 nos. answer scripts shall be paid by the School Education Department to the TBSE centrally for all the concerned High/Higher Secondary schools.

All the District Education Officers are requested to select Govt. and Govt. aided High and Higher Secondary Schools as per the schedule given in annexure -A.

They are also requested to circulate the Memo along with the programme schedule among all the Headmasters/Headmistresses of Govt. and Govt. aided High and Higher Secondary Schools under their jurisdiction to ensure compulsory attendance of the HMs along with 2 teachers from each school as per the date and time schedule.


